

2.1 The annual OSS Operating Plan encompasses the total amount of New Obligational Authority appropriated by Congress. The OSS Operating Plan is established at the beginning of each fiscal year and is updated as required by major budget changes.



6. PROCEDURE

<u>STEP #</u>	<u>ACTION OFFICERS</u>	<u>DESCRIPTION</u>
6.1	Code SP Program Analyst	Develop the OSS Initial Fiscal Year Operating Plan and associated input for incorporation into the NASA Plan. Input includes data that establish the funding controls and specific amounts for each program/project and explain any difference between the President's budget and the Operating Plan.
6.2	Code SP Program Analyst	Submit the OSS Initial Fiscal Year Operating Plan to Code B. <i>[Code B incorporates the input into the NASA Plan and coordinates resolution of issues with OSS and Code L.]</i>
6.3	Code SP Program Analyst	Prepare a request asking Code B to release resource authority to the Associate Administrator for Space Science.
6.4	Code SP Program Analyst Code SP Program Support Assistant	Following the receipt of release authority from Code B, release resource authority to the NASA Centers.
