
SUBJECT: Request for Relief of Requirement of Red-Line Copy in Purple package for NPR 2830.1A, NASA Enterprise Architecture Procedures

The Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) requests relief from the requirement to include a "red-lined" copy of all changes made to the proposed revision of NPR 2830.1 -NASA Enterprise Architecture Procedures.

The update to NPR 2830.1 within the OCIO has been ongoing for the past year, with numerous Agency management reviews and has successfully completed the union review. We are now scheduled to enter the NODIS review phase with a late May 2013, deadline for submittal of the purple package. Our NPR review team was notified by your staff on May 14, 2013, that there is a requirement that a red-line version of the draft document be included in the purple package.

While we agree with the benefit of typically including a red-line copy, the new document is a complete rewrite of the NPR, not incremental changes to the previous document. To manually create one red-lined copy at this point would require significant work and delay in the process. Also, the revised NPR 2830.1 is significantly different in structure and content than the previous version making it unproductive to view a redlined document.
